

## **EPR E Waste REGISTRATION**

### **Procedure:**

Procedure to be followed by the applicant and step by step movement of the application within the Department is same irrespective of risk category, size of firm (Micro, Small, Medium & Large), investor type (Foreign, Domestic) and business location (Rural, Urban).

**Introduction:** As per the provision of EWM Rules, Extended Producers Responsibility (EPR) for management of E waste is entrusted with the Producers and manufacturers, who introduce the products in the market. They are required to establish a system for management of E waste generated due to their products by engaging with the registered Recyclers and refurbishers. Local bodies are responsible for segregation of E Waste from municipal waste collection and channelisation to the Recyclers.

The Ministry of Environment, Forests, and Climate Change, Government of India, notified an amendment to the EWM Rules, 2022, according to which producers, manufacturers, Refurbishers and Recyclers shall comply with Extended Producer Responsibility as per Guidelines given in of EWM Rules.

According to EPR guidelines for E Waste Management, Producers, Manufacturers, recyclers and Refurbishers shall have to register through the centralized online EPR portal developed by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB).

### **Entity responsible to obtain EPR Registration**

Producers, manufacturers are required to ensure that E waste is processed through E Waste Recyclers/refurbishers in accordance with an action plan in order to meet assigned EPR targets. They shall obtain a E-Waste credit certificate based on the amount of E-waste processed by Recyclers/Refurbishers and use these certificates to meet their EPR targets. If any Entity fails to comply with EWM rules, environmental compensation will be imposed, as well as regulatory action.

The following entities shall register for EPR registration certificate on the centralized EPR portal developed by CPCB:

1. Producer
2. Manufacturer
3. Recyclers
4. Refurbishers

Producers/manufacturers in Micro Category exempted from this Rules.

All Entities are required to login to CPCB portal for EPR Registration [eprewastecpcb.in](http://eprewastecpcb.in). Registration applications are processed and issued by CPCB.

### **Step by Step Procedure to be followed by applicant:**

1. **Registration:** The applicant must register their company online on the CPCB portal by providing basic details and creating an account.
2. **Document Submission:** Submit the required documents along with the filled application form online.
3. **Review:** The CPCB scrutinizes the submitted documents and application. If any discrepancies are found, the applicant is required to rectify them.

4. **Approval or Rejection:** Once the application is reviewed, the CPCB either grants approval or rejects it, with reasons for rejection.
5. **EPR Plan Implementation:** Post approval, the company must follow the outlined waste management plan and submit annual reports on their waste disposal activities.

**Comprehensive list of documents:**

The following documents are required to be submitted during filing of Part A of the Application

- PDF copy of Company's PAN, CIN & GST (Max file size is 5MB)
- PDF copy of Authorized person PAN & Aadhar (Max file size is 5MB)
- PDF copy of Registration in case of renewal (if applicable) (Max file size is 5 MB) Details (type & quantity) of products produced/marketed (Max file size is 5MB)
- Representative video of E Waste processing/ Manufacturing) (Max file size is 5MB)
- Registration Certificate of District Industries Centre of the State Government or Union Territory, if applicable. (Max file size is 5MB)
- The Manufacturer/Recycler/Refurbishers is required to upload the copy of Consent to Operate under section Part B.
- The Recyclers has to upload copy of the hazardous Waste authorisation obtained from SPCB.
